What is Direct School Admission (DSA-Sec)?



- ❑ DSA-Sec Exercise was introduced in 2004.
- ❑ DSA-Sec Exercise seeks to promote holistic education.
- ❑ Direct School Admission (DSA) scheme provides students with the opportunity to seek admission to a secondary school, based on a diverse range of specific academic and non-academic achievements and talents that they can demonstrate beyond the Primary School Leaving Examination (PSLE).



Criteria for Applications

STEM (Boys & Girls)

Applicants should:

1. have a passion for Mathematics or Science, have an inquiring mind, and be able to work well in a team;
2. have obtained a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in Primary 5 and 6; and
3. demonstrate creative ways in problem-solving.

Only short-listed applicants will be invited to the school for the trial and an interview.

The session consists of:

- a) a **STEM assessment**; and
- b) an **interview**.

Meeting all the criteria does not guarantee that the student will be shortlisted / given an offer. Due to different profiles of applicants, selection/ shortlisting trends may differ year on year.

Criteria for Applications

Basketball (Boys)

Male applicants should:

1. have a passion for Basketball and be able to work well in a team;
2. have obtained a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in Primary 5 and 6; and
3. have attained at least a NAPFA 'Silver' Award or better in Primary 6.

Only short-listed applicants will be invited to the school for the trial and an interview.

The session consists of:

- a) a general physical ability test;
- b) a talent-specific test; and
- c) an interview.

The session consists of:

- a) a solo vocal performance;
- b) a talent-specific test; and
- c) an interview.

Meeting all the criteria does not guarantee that the student will be shortlisted / given an offer. Due to different profiles of applicants, selection/ shortlisting trends may differ year on year.

Criteria for Applications

English Drama (Boys & Girls)

Applicants should:

1. have a passion for Drama productions and acting, and be able to work well in a team; and
2. have obtained a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in Primary 5 and 6.

Only short-listed applicants will be invited to the school for the audition and an interview.

The session consists of:

- a) a solo performance;
- b) a dramatic delivery based on a short monologue provided; and
- c) an interview.

Meeting all the criteria does not guarantee that the student will be shortlisted / given an offer. Due to different profiles of applicants, selection/ shortlisting trends may differ year on year.

Performing Arts



Criteria for Applications

Marching Band (Boys & Girls)

Applicants should:

1. have a passion for music and playing in an ensemble, and be able to work well in a team; and
2. have obtained a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in Primary 5 and 6.

Only short-listed applicants will be invited to the school for the audition and an interview.

The session consists of:

- a) a solo performance on relevant Band instruments;
- b) aural tests and playing of scales; and
- c) an interview.

Meeting all the criteria does not guarantee that the student will be shortlisted / given an offer. Due to different profiles of applicants, selection/ shortlisting trends may differ year on year.

Performing Arts



Criteria for Applications

Modern Dance (Boys & Girls)

Applicants should:

1. have a passion for Dance and be able to work well in a team;
2. have obtained a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in Primary 5 and 6; and
3. exhibit a passion for dance and is able to express creativity in dance routines.

Only short-listed applicants will be invited to the school for the audition and an interview.

The session consists of:

- a) a solo dance performance;
- b) a performance reproduced based on a dance sequence provided; and
- c) an interview.

Meeting all the criteria does not guarantee that the student will be shortlisted / given an offer. Due to different profiles of applicants, selection/ shortlisting trends may differ year on year.

Interviews and Trials	Only for shortlisted applicants.
Upon admission via DSA	Students who are successfully admitted to the school via DSA are expected to honour their commitment to the school, and participate in the activities related to the talent they are selected for from year 1-4.
