



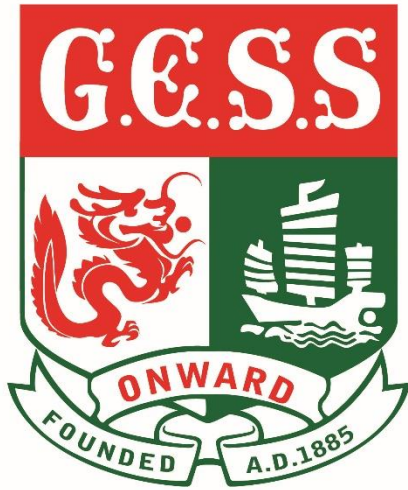

What is Direct School Admission (DSA-Sec)?



- ❑ DSA-Sec Exercise was introduced in 2004.
- ❑ DSA-Sec Exercise seeks to promote holistic education.
- ❑ DSA-Sec allows participating schools to select Primary Six students for admission to Secondary One based on the students' achievements and talents before the PSLE results are released.



Criteria for Applications

Applied Learning Programme

Applicants should:

STEM

1. Satisfy either of the following:
 - a. Have a passion for mathematics or science, with an inquiring mind, and works well in a team, or
 - b. Have participated and/or achieved awards in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics) related competitions.

2. Have obtained a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in Primary 5 and 6.

Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted to attend the selection interview consisting of a short STEM assessment.



Criteria for Applications

Basketball (Boys)

Sports

Male applicants should:

1. attach certified true copies of the following documents: testimonials and CCA records - P5 and P6 school results, teachers' remarks/comments, testimonials, CCA records, certificates of participation, representation and achievement in basketball (if any),
2. produce relevant documents for outstanding achievements at recognised competitions besides National School Games in basketball-relevant experiences (e.g. competitions),
3. state any relevant leadership position/roles held in Primary School,
4. attain a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in both Primary 5 (overall) and Primary 6 (mid-year),
5. attain Gold standard for NAPFA.

Only short-listed candidates will be contacted for a basketball skills assessment trial.



Criteria for Applications

Football (Boys)

Sports

Male applicants should:

1. attach certified true copies of the following documents: testimonials and CCA records - P5 and P6 school results, teachers' remarks/comments, testimonials, CCA records, certificates of participation, representation and achievement in football (if any),
2. produce relevant documents for outstanding achievements at recognised competitions besides National School Games in football-relevant experiences (e.g. competitions),
3. state any relevant leadership position/roles held in Primary School,
4. attain a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in both Primary 5 (overall) and Primary 6 (mid-year),
5. attain Gold standard for NAPFA.

Only short-listed candidates will be contacted for a football skills assessment trial.



Criteria for Applications

Table Tennis (Girls)

Sports

Female applicants should:

1. attach certified true copies of the following documents: testimonials and CCA records - P5 and P6 school results, teachers' remarks/comments, testimonials, CCA records, certificates of participation, representation and achievement in table tennis (if any),
2. produce relevant documents for outstanding achievements at recognised competitions besides National School Games in table tennis-relevant experiences (e.g. competitions),
3. state any relevant leadership position/roles held in Primary School,
4. attain a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in both Primary 5 (overall) and Primary 6 (mid-year),
5. attain Gold standard for NAPFA.

Only short-listed candidates will be contacted for a table tennis skills assessment trial.



Criteria for Applications

Choir

Performing Arts

Applicants should:

1. attach certified true copies of the following documents: testimonials and CCA records - P5 and P6 school results, teachers' remarks/comments, testimonials, CCA records, certificates of participation, representation and achievement in choir (if any),
2. produce relevant documents for outstanding achievements at recognised competitions in choir-relevant experiences (e.g. competitions),
3. state any relevant leadership position/roles held in Primary School,
4. achieved at least a Certificate of Accomplishment in recent SYF for primary school choir,
5. attained a minimum of Grade 3 from Music examinations for Voice (ABRSM, Trinity, NAFA etc),
6. attain a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in both Primary 5 (overall) and Primary 6 (mid-year).

Only short-listed candidates will be contacted for a selection trial on sight reading, singing scales and arpeggios and a 3-minute choice piece unaccompanied.



Criteria for Applications

Dance Ensemble

Performing Arts

Applicants should:

1. attach certified true copies of the following documents: testimonials and CCA records - P5 and P6 school results, teachers' remarks/comments, testimonials, CCA records, certificates of participation, representation and achievement in dance (if any),
2. produce relevant documents for outstanding achievements at recognised competitions in dance-relevant experiences (e.g. competitions),
3. state any relevant leadership position/roles held in Primary School,
4. have experiences in dance for at least 2 years as an active member of the Dance CCA in primary school or an external dance institution,
5. obtained a minimum of Silver award (or equivalent) in at least 2 dance competitions on a national level or 1 dance competition on an international level,
6. exhibits a passion for dance and have knowledge in and able to showcase at least 2 dance genres,
7. attain a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in both Primary 5 (overall) and Primary 6 (mid-year).

Only short-listed candidates will be contacted for a dance selection trial.



Criteria for Applications

Drama

Performing Arts

Applicants should:

1. attach certified true copies of the following documents: testimonials and CCA records - P5 and P6 school results, teachers' remarks/comments, testimonials, CCA records, certificates of participation, representation and achievement in drama (if any),
2. produce relevant documents for outstanding achievements at recognised competitions in drama-relevant experiences (e.g. competitions),
3. state any relevant leadership position/roles held in Primary School,
4. attain a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in both Primary 5 (overall) and Primary 6 (mid-year).

Only short-listed candidates will be contacted for an interview and a selection trial on vocal projection, articulation, interpretation of character, emotion, and stage movement followed by a scenario in which they will have to think creatively to improvise a scene.



Criteria for Applications

Military Band

Performing Arts

Applicants should:

1. attach certified true copies of the following documents: testimonials and CCA records - P5 and P6 school results, teachers' remarks/comments, testimonials, CCA records, certificates of participation, representation and achievement in band (if any),
2. produce relevant documents for outstanding achievements at recognised competitions in band-relevant experiences (e.g. competitions),
3. state any relevant leadership position/roles held in Primary School,
4. achieved at least a Certificate of Accomplishment in recent SYF for primary school band,
5. attained a minimum of Grade 3 from Music examinations (ABRSM, Trinity, NAFA etc) for relevant Band instruments,
6. attain a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in both Primary 5 (overall) and Primary 6 (mid-year).

Only short-listed candidates will be contacted for a selection trial on sight reading, playing of scales and arpeggios and performing a piece of music of choice (less than 3-minutes) that showcases ability on your instrument.
