Outcome of Appeal – by 19 January 2026 (Individual) and early-March 2026 (Group)

Candidates shall pay the appeal fees via SEAB Candidates Portal **by 20 January 2026**.



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CERTIFICATE AMENDMENT REQUEST

Candidates may request for a reprint of their current year examination certificate if their name was printed wrongly due to a **spelling error and did not reflect the name which they registered for their examination**. Other reasons for reprinting certificates will not be accepted.

There is an administrative fee of S\$50.00 (inclusive of GST) for the amendment of each GCE N-Level certificate.

Polytechnic Foundation Programmes (PFP)

PFP – eligible students will be issued a **Form ‘P’**

Interested students are required to submit their applications online via the PFP website at <https://pfp.polytechnic.edu.sg/PFP/index.html> using their SingPass account.

More information on the eligibility requirements for the PFP, as well as how O-Level results are considered in the computation of the ELMAB3 aggregate, can be found on the PFP website.



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Polytechnic Foundation Programmes (PFP)

Applications for the PFP will be open from **1.30 pm on Wednesday, 13 January 2026** until **4.30 pm on Monday, 19 January 2026**. The PFP posting results will be released at **1.30 pm on Monday, 26 January 2026** through the PFP website.

Students must indicate their decision to **accept, reject or appeal** for a change of course in the PFP Portal by **4.30 pm on Thursday, 29 January 2026**.

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Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

Eligible Secondary 4 N(A) students may submit their DPP Applications online via the DPP application portal at www.ite.edu.sg/apply-for-ite-courses.

The final application phase for the DPP will open from **12.00 am on Wednesday, 14 January 2026 to 11.59pm on Monday, 19 January 2026.**



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Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

The DPP posting results will be released **at 9.00 am on Wednesday, 21 January 2026** through the DPP application portal.

Students will be required to indicate whether they accept or reject the DPP offer by **11.59 pm on Monday, 26 January 2026**.



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Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

Students who have been offered a place in the DPP under the final application phase should report to ITE on **Monday, 26 January 2026**, upon acceptance of their DPP course offer.

The last day of school for Secondary 5 students who have accepted a place in the PFP will be **on Friday, 30 January 2025**. Students will be informed by the respective polytechnics on the enrolment dates for the PFP.

Students who accepted a place in the earlier application phase of the DPP in December but have now decided to take up a PFP offer will need to apply to ITE to withdraw from the DPP first, before they are able to take up the PFP offer.

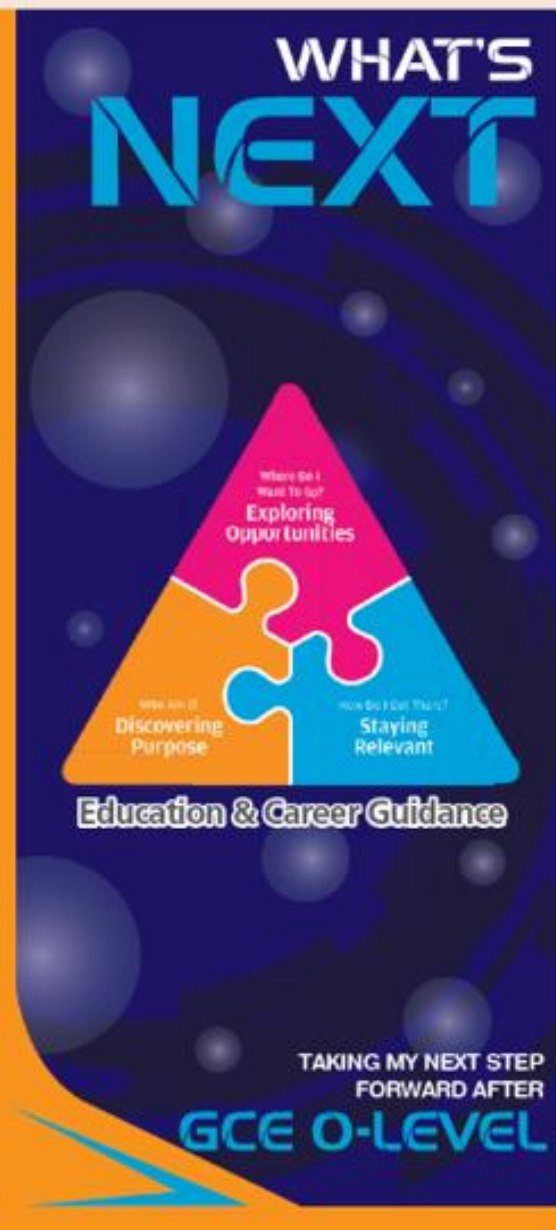
